



A healthy studio

Changes to our policy and procedures to make our dancers, staff and dance families safe.

These are guidelines put in place by ISDC and recommended by the CDC, State of Ohio and local health department.

If your child is not feeling well has a temperature , cough or showing symptoms of an illness, please do not send them to dance class.

ISDC is making changes to our policies and procedures in order to keep our staff and dance families safe.

* ISDC staff will be **wiping down surfaces** such as ballet barres, door handles, restrooms and other surfaces that dancers may come into contact with.

*We are reducing the sizes of our classes to keep within the 6 foot social distance guidelines.

*Our Lobby will be open for **drop off only**. Parents are required to wear masks and avoid mingling with others. Siblings are discouraged from coming into the building. We are removing all seating and will be marking off spaces for dancers and **ONE** responsible person to wait for class. We will not allow anyone into the lobby more than **5 minutes** before class start time and once the dancers go to class, parents will be asked to wait in their car or outside. Classes will be dismissed to the back studio door (in the Alley behind the studio). Please line up 5 minutes before the class is over with your pick up sign posted in the windshield. Please be courteous to all traffic and do not block 5th street.

Let's work together to keep everyone healthy!

*Combo level and older dancers need to bring a bag with their name and phone number clearly labeled on a tag and with an attached hand sanitizer. They can bring a filled water bottle with their name clearly labeled. Dancers should bring a small hand towel to place over the barre when doing barre work. We will not have a lost and found at this time so be certain to have all of your belongings before leaving.

*At this time we are not requiring the dancers to wear masks in class but if you feel more comfortable your dancer may wear one. Our staff and instructors will all be wearing masks and practicing frequent hand washing. Teachers may remove mask if participating in an exercise, but will maintain social distance.

*Please make sure your dancer uses the restroom and washes hands BEFORE coming to the studio. We will have restrooms available, but using it before arrival will minimize any extra exposure to germs.
